

3d quilled angel

Age:9-11 Group size: 10

Duration: 40 mins



Preparation time: 10 mins

Resources

- Strips of silver paper
1cms x 50cms
- Strips of yellow paper
1cms x 25cms
- Strips of flesh coloured
paper 1cms x 50cms
- 1cms x 4cms strips hair
colour
- 3mm x 10cms strips white
- Glue
- Scissors
- Felt tip pens
- pencil



Preparation

For one angel you need 8 strips of silver, 5 strips of flesh colour, 3 strips of hair colour, 2 of yellow and 3 of the thin white strips.

Activity

Roll the silver strips end on end to make a solid coil for the body. Push the centre up carefully. Glue

the inside to stop the angel from falling apart. Make a coil for the head using 5 strips of paper in the same way as for the body. Use the tip of a pencil to push out the centre, making a nose. Draw on eyes and mouth.



Make a coil from one strip of yellow. Let the coil go, controlling it with the fingers. Glue the end of the strip and pinch to form a wing shape. Repeat with the



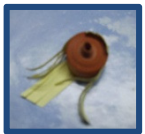
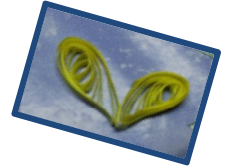

other strip of yellow and glue the pinched ends together to make a pair of wings. Stick the wings to the back of the body.



Cut fringes into the hair coloured pieces. Stick one on each side of the head and trim the other to fit on top of the head.

Make the halo using the 3 thin strips of white. Hold the 3 together at one end then twist them round and round until the end is reached. Take both ends and glue them together to form a circle. Stick the head onto the body and place the halo on top.
