

# Ripped wrapping paper card

Age:3-7 Group size: 6

Duration: 25 mins



Preparation time: 20 mins

## Resources

- Old Christmas cards/Christmas pictures
- Used wrapping paper/coloured paper strips 15cmsx5cms
- Glue
- Card A4
- Rulers



## Preparation

Sort out some fairly large pictures to stick on the front of the card. If you are going to make this card with children younger than 4 years old you

might like to rip the strips of paper for them. You will need about 8 strips per card.

## Activity

Fold the A4 card in half along the long side. Glue the back of a strip of paper and put the strip in line with the bottom of the card. Choose another strip. Take one of the long edges and a ruler. Put the ruler over the long edge so that the paper is sticking out underneath. Press down on the ruler and pull at the paper to give a ripped edge. Repeat with the other edge.

Glue the second strip over the top of the first strip. Carry on ripping and gluing on strips. When you reach the top of the card only rip one edge of the last strip.

Choose a picture to stick on the front of the card at a jaunty angle.
