

# Chocolate Nests

Age:3-6    Recipe makes 15-20

Duration: 25 mins



Preparation time: 15 mins

## Resources

- 250g bar of chocolate
- 150g rice crispies/cornflakes
- Saucepan
- Cooker
- Heatproof jug or bowl
- Water
- Large spoon
- Mixing bowl
- Cake cases
- Small spoons
- Mini eggs



## Preparation

Each child will need a paper cake case and a spoon.

## Activity

An adult should break the chocolate into chunks and place it in the heatproof jug or bowl. Fill a pan of water to a depth of about 4cms and sit the jug in it. Heat gently, stirring until melted.

Put the cornflakes or crispies into the mixing bowl. Cornflakes should be crushed a little. Pour in the chocolate and mix together until the cornflakes are covered. Put a dessertspoonful of mixture into each cake case. The children can use their teaspoon to make a well in the centre and spread the rest around the sides of the cake case to make a nest shape. Put a few little eggs into each nest and leave to cool or refrigerate.
