

Peg Magnet notepad holder

Age: 6-11 Group size: 20

Duration: 40 mins



Preparation time: 20 mins

Resources


- standard size wooden pegs
- paint
- fine brushes
- self adhesive magnetic discs

- foam, shapes, letters, pens, glitter etc for decoration
- pva glue
- paper



Preparation


Each child will need a peg and 2 magnets. Each group needs paint, glue and items for decoration.

Activity



Begin by giving the peg a coat of paint. Open the peg and paint inside first. Use a thin layer of paint. If the paint is thin enough it will dry within minutes.

While the peg is drying, make the notepad. Cut some paper using patterned scissors (about 6 sheets).



The paper could be decorated with a border or a rubbing. Stick 2 magnets on the back of the peg at the top and bottom. Add decoration to the front. A second peg could also be decorated to hold a pen. Note, if making a pen holder, glue the magnets on as they are not strong enough to hold too much weight.
