

3 hearts card

Age: 6-8

Group size: 10

Duration: 20 mins



Preparation time: 20mins

Resources

- Card – 24cmsx20cms
- Gluesticks
- Pink paper 10cmsx19cms
- Red card 10cmsx19cms
- Scraps of red card
- Scissors
- Templates – half hearts
- Pencils

Preparation

Make half heart templates in sets of 3, to fit closely together on the pink paper. Make 2 small ones and a larger one. Cut the card to size. You will need enough pairs of scissors for the children to have one each.



Activity

Fold the large card in half to make a base card that is 12cms wide and 20cms tall when closed. Fold the pink paper in half so that it is 5cms wide when closed. Place the straight edge of the half heart templates onto the paper, making sure they are not touching each other.



Draw around them and cut out. Glue the red card and put it down onto the pink paper so that it fits on top exactly. Glue the red card onto the base card. Cut little hearts out of red card, fold them in half and glue the fold line onto the card so that they sit on the card open.
