

# Tiger model

Age: 3-8

Group size: 4-8

Duration: 40mins in total



Preparation time: 25 mins

## Resources

- Egg boxes
- Pva glue
- Paint, white, orange, pink, black
- Wobbly eyes/felt scraps in white and black
- Black card/pipe cleaners
- Paintbrushes



## Preparation

The body is a whole egg box. The legs are 4 egg cups. The tail is a strip of card from offcuts. The head is half of an egg box

lid with a semi circle of card stuck on for the face. Ears are torn from curvy bits of the egg box. Tear any labels off the boxes.

## Activity

Tear 4 egg box cups and stick underneath a whole box to make 4 legs. Tear half an egg box lid. Take the edge of the half lid and hang it over the front of the egg box, add glue to keep it in place. Take the other half of the egg box lid and tear it into a semi circle. Stick this onto the front of the animal. Tear a strip from an egg box to make the tail, stick it to the back end. Glue two curvy bits from the edge of a lid, onto the head to make the ears.



## Tiger model

Age: 3-8

Group size: 4-8

Duration: 40mins in total



Paint the tiger orange and leave to dry. When the tiger is dry add black stripes. Paint the toes white and part of the face. The tiger has a cross piece of orange running under the eyes and down the nose. Above the eyes and around the mouth is white. Paint on a pink triangular nose and a black mouth. Stick on the eyes and add thin strips of black card or pipe cleaners for the whiskers.
