

Double pop-up card

Age: 8-11 Group size: 15

Duration: 30 mins



Preparation time: 30 mins

Resources

- Card 20cms x 12 cms
- Sprinkles
- Glue
- Scissors
- rulers
- Egg templates
- Pencils
- Plain paper
- Coloured paper 8cms x 6cms
- Coloured paper 20cms x12cms
- Glue stick or fine paintbrushes



Preparation

One large egg template is needed for the front and a smaller one for the inside. The big egg is 8cms long and the small ones 3cms. Each child will need a large piece of card and paper the same size, a piece of plain paper 9cms x 4cms for the little eggs, coloured paper 8cms x 6cms for the egg

on the front, pencil, ruler and scissors. Each group needs glue, glue sticks or paintbrushes, templates and a pot of sprinkles.

Activity

Take the piece of card with the narrowest side nearest you and fold it in half from top to bottom. Do the same with the large paper. Make the inside first. Draw around the small egg templates and decorate, then cut out.



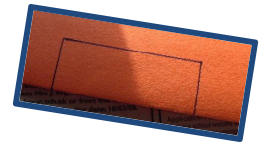
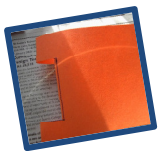
Double pop-up card

Age: 8-11 Group size: 15

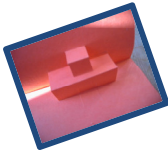
Duration: 30 mins



Take the folded paper (the insert). Measure 4cms from each end along the fold. At each of the 4cms marks measure and draw a straight line 2cms long towards the open side of the folded paper. Repeat at the other 4cms mark, then join the 2 short lines to make a rectangle. Cut the 2 short lines. Open the paper and push the rectangle inside so that the fold line for that bit folds the opposite way.



Find the middle of the closed step and make another 2 lines 1cms long. Again, cut the 2 short lines and push them inside.



Glue around the edges of the folded card and stick the pop-up inside. Glue the 3 small eggs to the edge of the steps.

Close the card. Take the paper which measures 8cms x 6cms. Draw around the large egg shape and cut out. Make a pattern with glue, cover in sprinkles and shake off. Stick the egg to the middle of the front of the card. Write the words "Happy Easter" in pencil down the sides of the card. Use a glue stick or the handle end of a fine paintbrush and glue over the writing. Cover in sprinkles and shake off.
