

# Paper bangles and beads

Age: 5-7 Group size: 25

Duration: 30 mins



Preparation time: 20 mins

## Resources

- Coloured paper – pages from catalogues are ideal, cut into strips about 1-2cm wide
- Glue
- Cotton, string or wool
- Thick, thin pencils or marker pens



## Technique

The beads are made by winding the strips of paper around the pens or pencils, gluing the end

and sliding off, then threading onto string. An adult can then, tie a loose knot to keep the jewellery in place. Choose a winding tool and then stick to it because different sized

beads can slip inside each other and ruin the effect. Beads can be made chunkier by using longer strips of paper.
